Transfer student ECE 115 options

ECE transfer students who satisfy all criteria:

Criteria 1) did not receive transfer credit for ECE 115, and

Criteria 2) have at least 2 credit hours in courses equivalent to portions of ECE 225, 265, 310, 322, 340, or 346, and

Criteria 3) have at least 2 credit hours in courses equivalent to portions of CS 111 or CS 107 or Matlab programming

have the following options (they must pick one, cannot opt for option 2 and then return to take ECE 115 as in option 1):

_____ Option 1) take ECE 115 for 4 credit hours before or concurrently with courses requiring ECE 115 ECE 225, 265, 310, 346. For these courses, ECE 115 pre-requisite becomes a co-requisite. Students must complete a Transfer Student ECE 115 Petition and drop it off with proper documentation in SEO 1020 for approval.

_____ Option 2) be waived ECE 115 and granted access to higher level ECE courses requiring ECE 115 — ECE 225, 265, 310, 346. For these courses, the 115 pre-requisite is waived, and the student must make up for the 4 credit hours from ECE 115 in ECE courses at or above the 200 level that are not being used to fulfill other graduation requirements. Students must complete a Transfer Student ECE 115 Petition and drop it off with proper documentation in SEO 1020 for approval.
